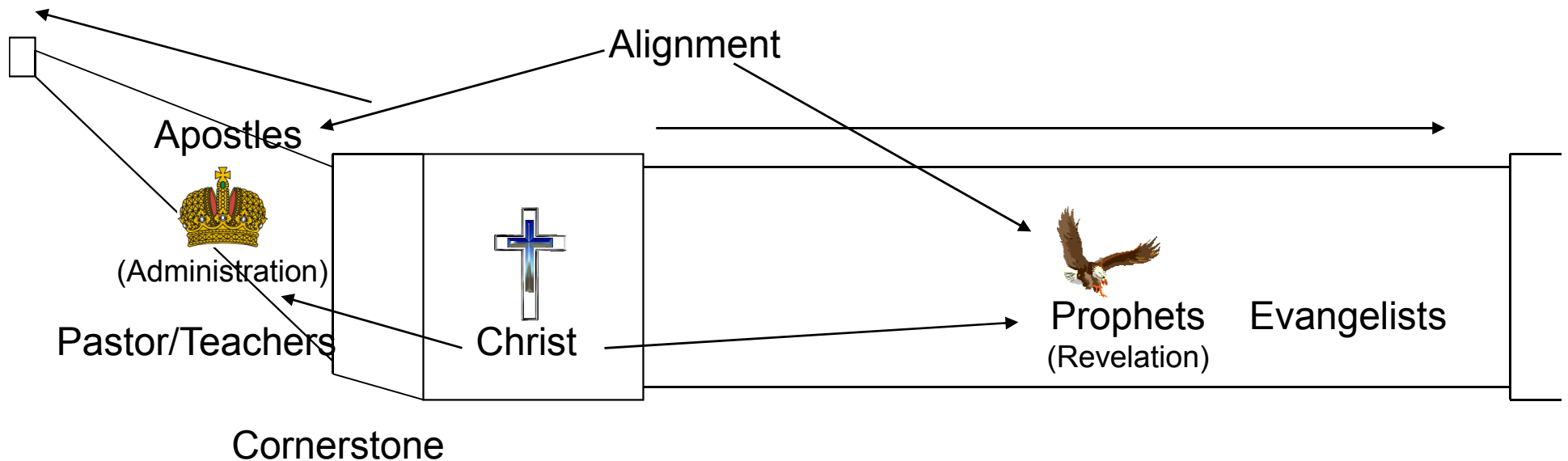

The cornerstone defines the alignment of the foundation, and insures its straightness. Therefore every stone in the foundation must be in line with the cornerstone. (1Peter2:5)

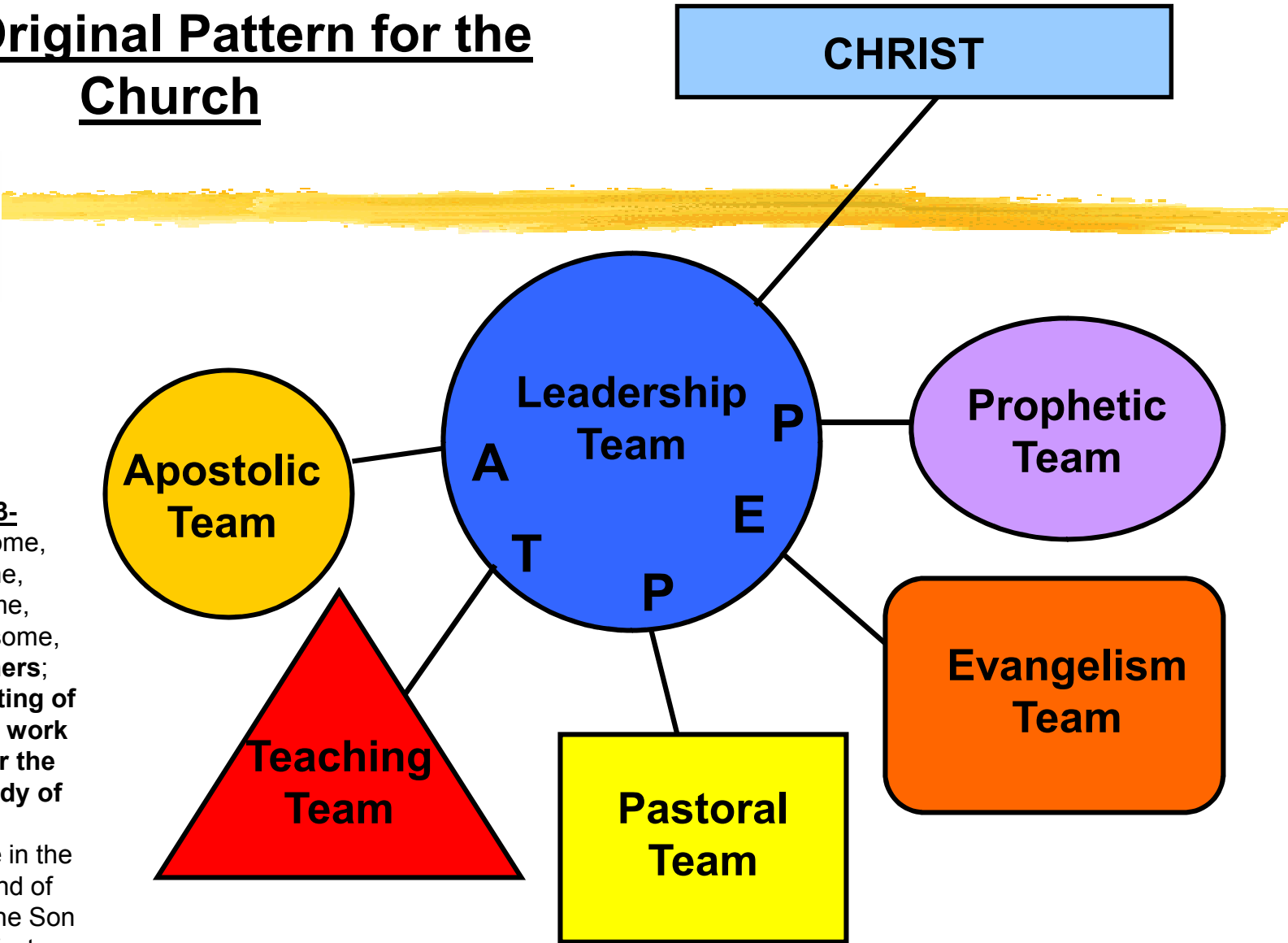
In October 2006, God revealed to Elders Harry and Cheryl Jackson that they were to begin preparations to move into a new dimension of ministry. In seeking the Lord for His vision for their lives, they became aware of the need in the Body of Christ for the teaching of sound doctrine, reverence for the Bible as the only infallible written Word of God and of Jesus Christ alone as the chief cornerstone of the Church. Therefore God gave them a vision to start a non-traditional ministry which would help the church to reestablish itself upon the sure foundation of Christ. Its mission would be to restore God's true apostolic pattern for the Church (according to Acts 2:42-47) by creating an environment by which believers can be biblically trained, equipped, and released into their divine destinies. In February of 2007, armed with 1 Corinthians 3:11- "For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ," the Jacksons began to lay the groundwork for Christ Foundation Church and Ministries. The ministry was incorporated in March 2007, and the Jacksons were installed as its overseers in May of 2007. CFCM is now doing its part in the great work of building God's people on the sure foundation of Jesus Christ and establishing the Kingdom of God.

What We Believe

We believe that it is God's desire to restore His original pattern, according to the New Testament, to the Church.

This pattern consists of a Body of saved, Holy Spirit-filled disciples empowered for service with spiritual gifts and overseen by a company of servant-leaders (Elders or Overseers) whose function is not to rule, but to lead by Christ-like example, and are accountable to the Church body, to one another, and ultimately to God the Father and to Jesus Christ, who is the Head and Chief Cornerstone of the Church.

God's Original Pattern for the Church



Ephesians 4:11-13-

How the 5-fold ministry dynamic facilitates duplication of gifts and prepares believers for service.



Methodology:

CFCM is a static organization as well as a mobile ministry team whose goals are to:

- 1. Assemble and train five-fold ministers (Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Pastors, and Teachers) whose function would be to prepare people of God to be released into ministry.**
- 2. Interface with local, national and international church bodies in order to facilitate seminars, training sessions, conferences and presentations.**
- 3. Communicate and then build upon the foundational tenets of the Christian faith through preaching, teaching and sharing opportunities as they arise in local, national and international arenas.**
- 4. Avail ourselves of modern media assets (television, radio, audio, video, internet, etc.) to facilitate the spread of the Gospel as well as the Christ Foundation vision.**



Ministry Focus:

1. The Word of God- the divine authority of the Holy Scriptures (2Tim 3:16).
2. Individual relationship with God through worship and prayer (Jn. 4:24, Eph. 6:18).
3. Corporate worship and Christian fellowship (Jn. 4:24-26, 1 Cor. 14:26, 1 Pet. 4:10, Heb. 10:25).
4. Sound doctrine and instruction in righteousness (2 Tim. 3:16, 2 Tim. 4:1-5).
5. Preparation for service and duplication of gifts (Eph. 4:11, 2 Tim. 2:2).
6. Releasing believers into ministry (Ac. 6:6, 1 Tim. 4:14, 1 Tim. 5:2, 2 Tim. 1:6).
7. Reaching the lost through evangelism (Mk 16:15, 2 Cor. 5:18-21).
8. Impacting the nations through world ministry (Mk. 16:15).

Our Colors:

White- signifies the new life in Jesus Christ and the righteousness, holiness and purity that He imparts to us as we daily walk in total dependence on Him.

Black- signifies the death of the old self, and the habits, thought-patterns and attachments to the life that characterizes the world outside of the Kingdom of God.

Gold- signifies the end-product of the training and testing process that God employs to produce His character, His virtue, and His mighty power in us.

What the various elements of the CFCM Logo represent...

This vertical line represents the **Prophets**, who through their vertical relationship with God, receive revelation for the Body of Christ.

This top line represents **The Word of God**- the straightedge of the Masterbuilder, which aligns the entire structure with the Cross, which, of course, represents **Christ, the Chief Cornerstone.**

Ephesians 2:20b expresses the defining characteristic of both the Body of Christ and the CFCM Ministry, that they are “...**built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone...**”

CFCM was founded on **Feb. 3, 2007.**



This horizontal line represents the **Apostles**, who undergird the Body of Christ by providing government, administration and stability.

1Cor. 3:11 expresses the CFCM Ministry's message to the Church and to the world: “**For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ.**”
