**Isaiah 6:1-6-**

**1: In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple.**

**2: Above it stood the seraphims: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly.**

**3: And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory.**

**4: And the posts of the door moved at the voice of him that cried, and the house was filled with smoke.**

**5: Then said I, Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts.**

**6: Then flew one of the seraphims unto me, having a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar:**

**7: And he laid it upon my mouth, and said, Lo, this hath touched thy lips; and thine iniquity is taken away, and thy sin purged.**

**8: Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then said I, Here am I; send me.**



**“The ancient Greek philosopher Aristotle used the word *“Telos”* to define the complete fulfillment or design of a thing. He proposed that everything that is made is made for a reason, and that it has intrinsically built into it all that it needs to bring it to a state of *“eudaimonia,”* which means flourishing, being fulfilled. God created everything with a purpose, and he created man, and man alone with the ability to ask, “Why? Why am I here? What is it that I am supposed to do in the time that I am here? What is my *telos*? What is my purpose? When will I know that I have found it? And what am I to do once I’ve found out what it is?”**

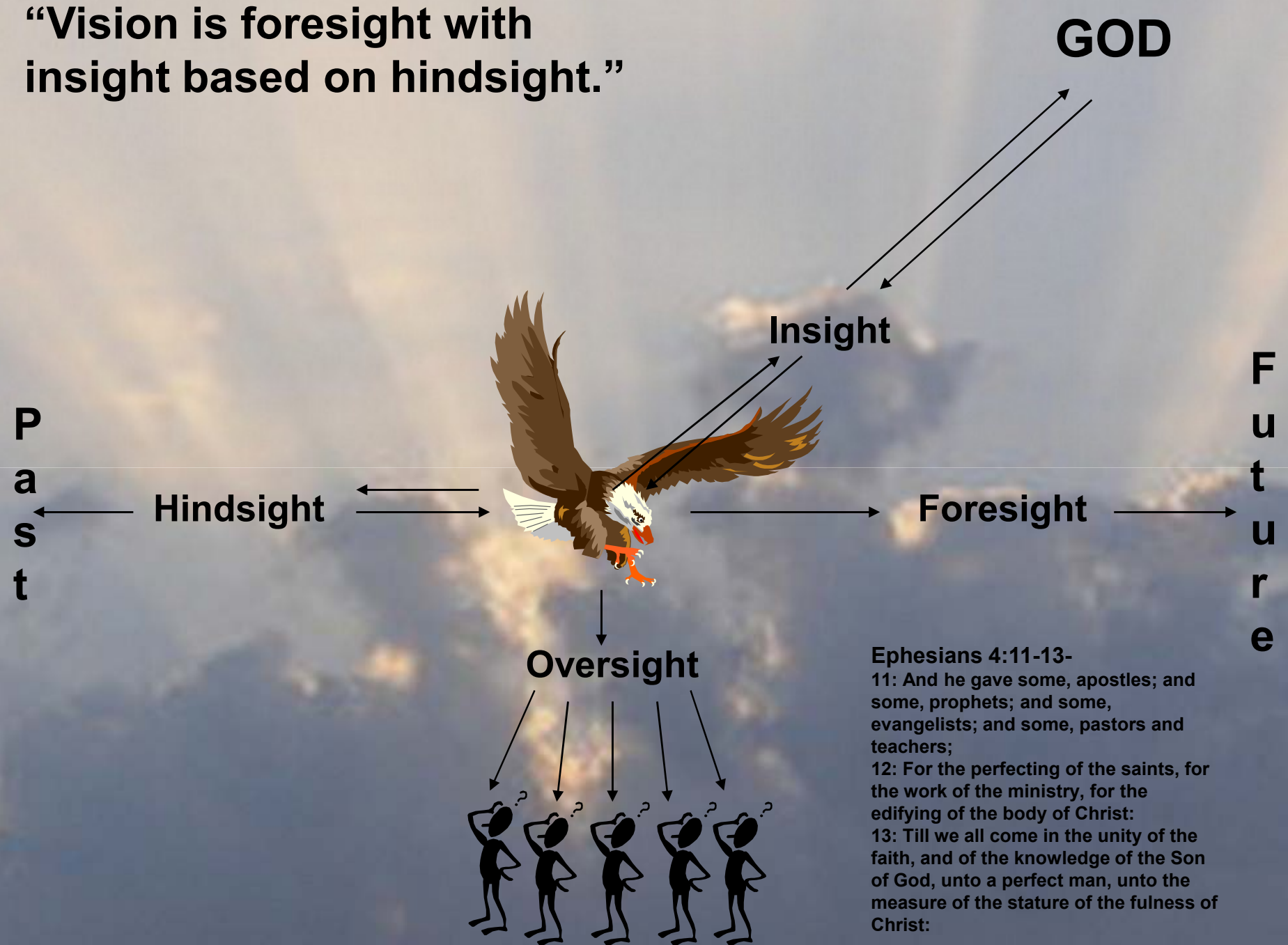

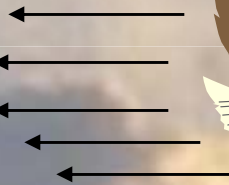

# Recovering Your Vision

## **What David Had To Do To Recover His Vision (*1 Samuel 30*):**

- **Avoid discouragement (especially before the people). (vs. 6)**
- **Ignore Criticism. (vs. 6)**
- **Seek God with a mind to hear and obey. (vs. 8-9)**
- **Commit to worship and prayer. (vs. 7-8)**
- **Engage the enemy. (vs. 17)**
